



2024 Planning Leads to Intense Focus in Kingstown

Last Fall, the coalition began a partnership with the Kingstown community to pilot a model plan to improve health outcomes in their community. The goal is to take what we learn in Kingstown and share with other Cleveland County communities over the next five years.

During the steering committee's annual planning session in January, Donna Albertone with Population Health Improvement Partners, led and challenged the committee with thinking about our next steps and moving beyond the typical talking to more intentional, sustainable actions. The committee determined that the work in Kingstown cannot begin without having community representatives on the steering committee. The steering committee is currently recruiting three Kingstown residents to join the steering committee. Including residents on the steering committee will help with understanding community history, first-hand experiences, and potential solutions to improve health.

While there is a primary focus in Kingstown, the coalition will continue to support action plan initiatives throughout the county. More information will be shared at the first quarterly coalition meeting:

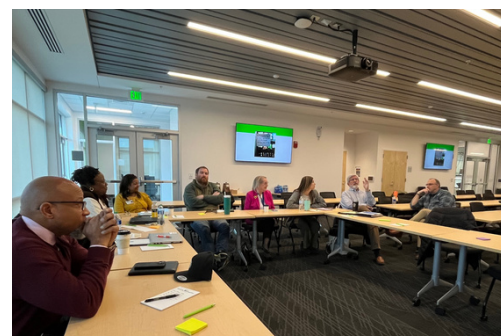

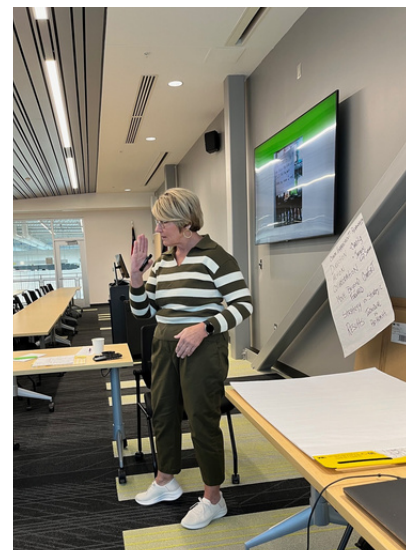
